

# **St. Pius X Parish School Distance Learning Plan 2020-2021**

## **Details**

- The distance learning schedule will closely follow the in-person student schedule.
- Core subjects will be taught daily for all grade levels.
- Each teacher will be sending their class schedules out via email.
- Students will be allotted recess and lunch breaks in between virtual classes.
- All teachers will be offering a daily office hour in the afternoon where students may login to the Google Meet. This time is for additional support in core subjects and to allow for students to ask additional questions in regards to a lesson or assignment.
- Teachers will be using Google Meets to teach virtually and all lessons will be recorded for students who are unable to attend during the set times.
- All assignments and projects will be assigned using Google Classroom.
- Assessments will be given weekly using a variety of platforms, this is dependent on the grade level.
- Daily and weekly assignments will be given to students to complete by the due date.
- Teachers will message parents if their child is not attending the virtual classes or not turning in their assignments.
- Student grades will be updated weekly via Gradelink.
- Students will receive PE virtually  
(Mrs. Kaufman: TK-2nd, Mrs. Ross: 3rd-8th grade).

### **Specials Classes:**

During distance learning we will be offering additional classes/clubs.

- Student Council Members will have meetings via Google Meets.
- Creative Writing/Journalism Class for grades 5-8 once a week.
- Graphic Design Club for grades 4-8 once a week.
- Story Time/Book Club for grades TK-4th once a week.
- Early Childhood Directed Drawing/Art Club in the afternoon for TK-3rd grade once a week.

### **Expectations/Google Etiquette:**

- Late assignments without a parent excuse will result in points being deducted.
- Students are required to have their camera on, and show their face during virtual lessons.
- Students are expected to participate in virtual lessons.
- Classroom etiquette and rules are the same during distance learning as they are when present at school.
- Students must be appropriately dressed.
- Backgrounds must be appropriate.
- Students should use recess and lunch time to eat, students should not be eating during virtual lessons.
